Public water services:



 124 litres per inhabitant per day (declining trend)

... but significantly affected by climate change

Impacts of climate change

Droughts

Rising water demand Quantity of drinking water resources (water allocation issues) Quality (less dillution of pollutants)

Floods

Combined sewer overflows

Rising temperatures

Quality of drinking water resources and drinking water

Rising sea-levels

Salt water intrusion in aquifers

Adaptation to climate change

Drinking water

Risk management

Resources and abstraction management, interconnectors, appeals to save water

Water allocation schemes

Prioritising public water supply (CZ, ES, NL), protecting water from pollution, favouring water reuse

Contingency plans

Coordination between utilities, municipalities, authorities, civil protection bodies.

Leakage reduction

See drinking water directive Investment capacity needed

Adaptation to climate change

Waste water

Risk management

Prevent storm water from reaching sewers through nature-based solutions

Manage run-off

Reduce combined sewer overflows (separate sewers, storm water storage)



Water recycling

Enhance water reuse, protect waste water from chemicals pollution

Water sector needs



Coordinated approach

including all relevant actors (urban planning, river basin planning)

Implement legislation

Water Framework Directive, make Drought management plans compulsory

No one-size-fits-all

EU/national strategies but local solutions

Ensure financing

Through cost recovery incl. EU and national public funding, Recovery Fund

Reduce pollution

by applying the precautionary and control-atsource principles
