


KNOWLEDGE

To deal with the problem of litter, it is necessary to know more about its quantity, composition, origin, areas of accumulation, etc. Using data compiled by volunteers, we can identify effective solutions for preventing it. And so we work together with NGOs and universities to develop methods and innovative tools that increase our knowledge of the various land, sea and river ecosystems.

We support Citizen Science by developing the tools and methodologies that make it possible.


KNOWLEDGE: SCIENCE

Libera bets on knowledge and also on science. That is why we have started the development of a scientific project that will adress the most dangerous consequences of human activity in natural areas like habitat destruction and environmental polution. These problems affect directly to the species, resulting in the loss of biodiversity all around the planet.

That same problem is caused by the effect of the scattered litter that we all can find in thousands of natural areas. With the collaboration of the **Spanish National Research Council** (CSIC), the biggest public research organism in Spain and the third in all Europe, the biggest aim for this **LIBERA science** project is to identify and to quantify the presence of contaminants and litter in these spots marked as **Important Bird and Biodiversity Areas** (IBA) through the analysis and periodic clean-up's and characterization.








PREVENTION




LIBERA also works to provide natural areas with information at entry points and resources, such as signage and identification, that increase user awareness of proper litter disposal.
