- Enables sustainable, just transition pathways to a climate-neutral & nature-positive 2050.

Bioeconomy policy ever more important in the current food and energy crisis

- Transition to resilient and sustainable food systems & clean energy
- Respecting ecosystem boundaries
- Managing potential trade-offs from a holistic perspective

EU definition

Bioeconomy encompasses all sectors and associated services and investments that produce, use, process, distribute or consume biological resources, including ecosystem services. As such it is a natural enabler and result of the European Green Deal transformation.

Focus on the overall consumption of biological resources
