### **Existing EPR rules in EU legislation**

- Waste Framework Directive 2008/98/EC: Article 8 and 8a
- End-of-Life Vehicles Directive 2000/53/EC: Article 5(4)
- WEEE Directive 2012/19/EC: Article 12 and 13
- Batteries Directive 2006/66/EC: Article 16
- Packaging and Packaging Waste Directive 94/62/EC: Article 7(2)
- Single-use Plastics Directive: Article 8



#### **New initiatives**

- Proposal for a Regulation on Batteries and Waste Batteries (December 2020)
- Proposal for a Regulation on Packaging and Packaging Waste (expected by end 2022)
- Revision of the End-of-Life Vehicles Directive (planned for 2023)
- Amendment to the Waste Framework Directive (planned for 2023)



### Trending EPR questions 1 Online sales

- Free riding: how to reach producers outside EU
  - Distortion of competition disadvantaging compliant producers
  - MS reporting on recycling rates not corresponding to reality
- Exponential growth in online sales especially due to the Covid-19 pandemic
- Some national initiatives to address (FR, DE, ...)
- New pieces of EU product legislation builds on the principles of Digital Services Act (General Product Safety Regulation, Batteries, Eco-design for Sustainable Products)



## Trending EPR questions 2 Cross-border EPR

- Products ending up as waste in another MS than where it was placed on the market
  - Products sold in brick and mortar-shops
  - Online sales
- → cooperation between economic operators/producers and waste management operators
- → need for upstream measures enabling traceability of the product, such as digital product passport and establishment of product/producer registers



### Trending EPR questions 3 Expanding EPR to additional sectors

- MS can introduce EPR schemes for additional sectors
- On EU level:
  - Textiles: amendment to the Waste Framework Directive
    - → 2018 WFD amendment with separate collection requirement for textile waste
    - → 2019 European Green Deal
    - → 2020 Circular economy action plan
    - → 2022 Textiles Strategy

Which other product categories should be new priorities for EPR, also in relation to critical raw materials?
